

OTHER SPECIFICATIONS WIRE-O BOUND



Closed Open

Wire-O binding has few limitations. It uses the entire final trim size for the image area. Books that are 0.5" to 1" thick are punched 0.375" from the edge of the sheet, leaving a margin for text and graphics of 0.625". Books up to 0.5" thick are punched 0.25" from the edge of the page, and should have a margin of 0.5" for type and graphics.

Wire-O Binding

Binding books along the edge using double loops of wire; this allows the book to lie flat when opened.

Document Size: Set your document up with single pages, instead of facing pages in your pagination program. This allows the pages to be pulled apart to adjust the bleeds that fall into the grind for a seamless crossover.

Page Count: The number of pages in your book must be divisible by 4 [i.e., 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 28, 32, 36...].



From edge of page to punches is 0.25"

Facing pages in your pagination program are not recommended.
No manipulation needed on crossover.



Bleed 0.125" on all 4 sides.

Start of Visual Image area 0.375"
[For images and graphics that are not intended to bleed.]
